

Documents required when applying for an entry visa:

- passport (valid at least for the duration of the proposed stay);
- two completed visa application forms;
- two identical, recent passport-size photographs;
- copy of proposed travel itinerary (issued by travel agent or airline);
- copy of residence permit (if resident in country other than country of nationality);
- letter from employer in case of business travel;
 - SFrs. 40.00 per entry
 - SFrs. 6.00 (registered mail within Switzerland)
 - SFrs. 12.00 (registered mail for Austria, France, Germany & Italy)

Please note that applications for entry visa should be submitted to the Consulate General at least two weeks before the proposed departure date. **Payment in Swiss Francs only**, must be made either in person to the Consulate or by postal order made out to the "Consulate General of Trinidad and Tobago, Geneva"

An application for an Entry Visa must be submitted to a Trinidad and Tobago Mission abroad or where there is no Trinidad and Tobago Office, to a UK Embassy or Consulate in a non-Commonwealth country.

SCHENGEN VISA INFORMATION FOR TRINIDAD & TOBAGO NATIONALS

The Schengen Visa is issued by Embassies or Consulates of the following countries:

Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Iceland, Italy, Luxemburg, the Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Spain, Sweden and Switzerland.

This visa allows the holder to move freely in all these countries within the validity of the visa.

However, please note that:

If you are not a resident of Switzerland, or European Union, you should apply at the Embassy or Consulate of the Schengen state you wish to travel to in Trinidad and Tobago.

If you intend to visit only one Schengen country, you must apply for a visa at the Embassy or Consulate of that country.

If you intend to visit several Schengen countries, you must apply for a visa at the Embassy or country in which your **main destination is situated**.

If you intend to visit several countries without having a main destination, you should apply for a visa at the Embassy or Consulate of the Schengen country of your first port of entry.
