Senator the Honourable Dr. Amery Browne, Minister of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs met with

2022 at the Ministry's offices in St. Clair.

The Ambassador presented his Letters of Credence to Her Excellency Paula-Mae Weekes O.R.T.T.,

4th May, 2022, while the Minister was on official overseas travel. This was, therefore, the first

opportunity for the Minister and Ambassador to meet at the Ministry.

importance of continued energy cooperation.

Republic of Trinidad and Tobago and CARICOM against attempts to promote the exclusion of the

Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela from the world stage.
