Mr. Conrad Enill has been appointed High Commissioner for the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago to the Cooperative Republic of Guyana.

During a brief presentation ceremony held recently, Senator the Honourable Dr. Amery Browne, Minister of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs presented Mr. Enill with his Instrument of Appointment, expressing appreciation for his willingness to serve Trinidad and Tobago. The Minister indicated that His Excellency would be guided by the Government's policy framework, which underscores that the Ministry of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs and its diplomatic network of overseas missions must be the frontline of projecting the interests of Trinidad and Tobago internationally.
