CHAUFFEUR/DRIVER-MESSENGER

Duties and Responsibilities

- To transport the High Commissioner and other officers and officials safely to and from engagements
- To collect and deliver correspondence in a timely manner
- To secure correspondence
- To ensure the delivery of payment of all bills for the High Commission
- To deliver/collect all letters pertaining to banking transactions at the High Commission's bank (including bank deposits)
- To ensure that the vehicle is properly maintained and clean at all times
- To check for essentials such as gas, oil, water and tyre pressure
- To ensure that the scheduled servicing appointments are kept
- To report to senior officers any defects in the vehicle
- To ensure that all documentation related to the vehicle is kept updated such as Insurance and Inspection

Required Skills and Competencies

- Knowledge of defensive driving techniques
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Knowledge of the road networks of Guyana and locations of relevant Government Agencies, Diplomatic Missions and other relevant offices

Experience and Training
