Among the issues receiving the attention of CARICOM Foreign Ministers were the Community's engagement with the Republic of Korea, Azerbaijan, Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO), United Arab Emirates (UAE) and the United States of America (USA). St. Vincent and the Grenadines, in its capacity as President Pro Tempore of the Community of Latin American and Caribbean States (CELAC), presented on a number of key areas of focus during its tenure.
