Senator the Honourable Dr. Amery Browne, Minister of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs, met with the Trinidad and Tobago Education Working Group, at the Ministry of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs on 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2023.

The Trinidad and Tobago Education Working Group is a group of stakeholders which seeks to identify opportunities for the delivery of education services to migrant children in Trinidad and Tobago.
