Reflecting that the year 2024 marks the 30th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between Trinidad and Tobago and Panama, the Minister complimented the strength of cultural cooperation in art, literature, film and cuisine exhibitions, during Her Excellency's stewardship. He underscored that this aspect of the bilateral relationship is taken very seriously, especially in light of the historical context.
