The Meeting's discussions centered on the High Level United Nations Conference to Support the Implementation of Sustainable Development Goal 14: Conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas and marine resources for sustainable development (the 2025 UN Ocean Conference) scheduled to take place from 9th to 13th June, 2025 in Nice, France. The Conference will be hosted jointly with Costa Rica.

During the discussions, Ambassador Chabert outlined the Conference's objective of bringing together stakeholders at the political and technical levels to establish a new ocean Agenda.
