## NOTARY, CERTIFICATION AND AUTHENTICATION OF DOCUMENTS

### A. NOTARY PUBLIC

The High Commission provides Notary Services in respect of letters, agreements, forms and legal documents.

This service is provided by appointment only. To make an appointment call +44 (0)20-7245-9351, select Option 3 or send an e-mail to [hclondonconsular@foreign.gov.tt](mailto:hclondonconsular@foreign.gov.tt).

The applicant is required to provide the original document, a valid photo ID and fees at the time of the appointment. The applicant must sign the original document in the presence of the Notary Public at the High Commission.

The fee for this service is £10.00 per page and is payable by cash only.

### B. CERTIFIED COPY

The High Commission can provide a certified copy of an original document.

This service is provided by appointment only. To make an appointment call +44 (0)20-7245-9351, select Option 3 or e-mail [hclondonconsular@foreign.gov.tt](mailto:hclondonconsular@foreign.gov.tt) to make an appointment.

The applicant is required to provide the original document, a photocopy of the document, a valid photo ID and fees at the time of the appointment.

The fee for this service is £10.00 per page and is payable by cash only.

### C. AUTHENTICATION OF DOCUMENTS

Certain documents issued by the various Ministries of the Government of The Republic of Trinidad and Tobago are authenticated by an Apostille. The Apostille is either issued by the Registrar General Department, Ministry of Legal Affairs or the Ministry of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs in Trinidad and Tobago.

Applicants should send an e-mail with a scan of the document they require authenticated to [hclondonconsular@foreign.gov.tt](mailto:hclondonconsular@foreign.gov.tt) to obtain guidance.
