TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO REAFFIRMS SUSTAINED SECURITY COOPERATION WITH UNITED STATES

PORT OF SPAIN: 15TH DECEMBER, 2025

The Ministry of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs reaffirms the Government of Trinidad and Tobago's (GORTT's) commitment to sustained cooperation with the United States of America (U.S.A.) in advancing regional safety, security, and stability.

Through this partnership, Trinidad and Tobago has benefited from joint military training exercises, enhanced surveillance capabilities, including the installation of an effective radar system, *and* collaborative efforts that have contributed to the interdiction of millions of dollars' worth of illegal narcotics.

The United States Embassy in Trinidad and Tobago has also supported national development through educational initiatives, including school equipment donations and infrastructure enhancement projects.

In keeping with established bilateral cooperation, the Ministry has granted approvals for United States military aircraft to transit Trinidad and Tobago's airports in the coming weeks. The United States has advised that these movements are logistical in nature, facilitating supply replenishment and routine personnel rotations.

The Honourable Sean Sobers M.P. Minister of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs, welcomes the continued collaboration:

"The Ministry of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs maintains close engagement with the United States Embassy in Trinidad and Tobago.
