### **ADVISORY FROM THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AND CARICOM AFFAIRS ON DEVELOPMENTS IN THE MIDDLE EAST**

The Ministry of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago is closely observing the evolving developments in the Middle East.

Nationals are strongly encouraged to undertake the following precautionary actions:

- Remain indoors in a secure location, avoid all travel and follow instructions from the local authorities
- Stay vigilant and informed by monitoring credible news sources and official advisories.
- Register promptly with the Ministry's Registration System for Nationals Abroad: <https://register.foreign.gov.tt/>.
- Ensure that all travel documents are valid and up to date.
- Comply fully with safety and security directives issued by local authorities.
- Ascertain the location of the nearest emergency shelter in the event of intensifying hostilities.
- Formulate contingency plans for departure, particularly where personal safety may be at risk.

Nationals are also reminded that holders of Trinidad and Tobago passports are required to obtain a visa for transit through or entry into the United Kingdom.

This requirement should be factored into all travel plans.
