- Prepares position briefs, presentations and speeches on different aspects of the Revised Treaty of Chaguaramas
- Designs brochures and other written material on CSME.
- Represents and defends the interests of GOROTT on CSME matters at relevant regional forums.
- Arranges for the dissemination by the various media of information on developments related to CSME
- Plans, coordinates and participates in research projects on matters pertinent to the Public Education Programme.
- Arranges seminars, town hall meetings, press conferences and consultations on the CSME.
- Conducts presentations and workshops on CSME.
