## OST, STOLEN OR MUTILATED PASSPORT CHECKLIST

## **IDENTIFICATION OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO PASSPORT:**

- Trinidad and Tobago passports that are <u>not</u> Machine Readable start with <u>six (6) digits</u> 123456 or <u>one (1) letter</u> and <u>six (6) digits</u> T456789 or B987654.
- Trinidad and Tobago passports that are Machine Readable start with <u>two (2) letters</u> and <u>six (6)</u>
  <u>digits</u> TA123456, TB987654, TC456789 or TB654321.

Complete application form using either <u>blue</u> or <u>black</u> ink. The use of correction fluid (whiteout) and erasable pens is <u>NOT</u> permitted, when completing the application. Form can be obtained from our website at <u>www.foreign.gov.tt/embwashington</u>

All applicants whose last issued Trinidad and Tobago passport (valid or expired), that has been lost, stolen or mutilated (damaged), must complete and submit a 'Lost, Stolen or Mutilated Notification form' along with:

1. The **first (1<sup>st</sup>) Machine Readable passport** form, along with copies of supporting documents, should be **emailed** to <a href="emailed-to-embdcpass@foreign.gov.tt">embdcpass@foreign.gov.tt</a> Once applications are reviewed, applicant will be contacted within ten (10) – fourteen (14) business days to schedule their appointment.

OR

2. The **Machine Readable passport renewal** form along with supporting documents, should be submitted via **mail** or in "**drop box**" located at the Embassy.

Produce two (2) **coloured copies** of all documents listed below when submitting the Lost, Stolen/Mutilated Notification Form.

- Completed Lost, Stolen/Mutilated Notification Form with the RED BORDER along with a photocopy of the lost passport, if available. Application form must be notarised.
- Mutilated passport <u>must</u> be submitted with application.
- Trinidad and Tobago Computer Generated Birth Certificate or Adoption Certificate, if applicable. If the applicant is not a citizen of Trinidad and Tobago by birth, their Original Birth Certificate/Adoption Certificate from the respective country must be produced; along with relevant official translations where necessary.
- Photo identification required; (Permanent Resident Card, Driver's License, State or National Issued Identification, Work Authorization Card). Please provide all applicable forms of ID available.
- Police Report/Incident Report is <u>MANDATORY</u> if your passport was <u>lost</u> or <u>stolen</u>.
- Two (2) high quality coloured passport sized (2" x 2") photos, white background, no smiling, no glasses, no facial piercings, both ears visible, no hair on forehead, no shadows. *Photocopy of photos are not necessary.*
- o Trinidad and Tobago Restoration, Registration or Naturalization Certificate, if applicable.
- Naturalization or Registration Certificate for country of citizenship other than Trinidad and Tobago, if applicable.
- Name Change document or Deed Poll, if applicable.
- Marriage Certificate for <u>each</u> Marriage, with affixed seal/stamp from relevant judicial authority (applicable to women only).
- Divorce Decree, Legal Separation or Death Certificate for <u>each</u> dissolved marriage, with affixed seal/stamp from relevant judicial authority (applicable to women only).

Additional documents may be required on a case-by-case basis.

<u>PAYMENTS</u>: All payments must be made payable to "<u>Embassy of Trinidad and Tobago"</u> by money order only.

- All applicants under <u>two (2) years of age</u> or <u>sixty (60) years and over</u> a money order for <u>\$20.00</u> is required.
- For persons age two (2) through fifty-nine (59) years old a money order for \$60.00 is required, if passport was lost and already expired.
- For persons age two (2) through fifty-nine (59) years old a money order for \$180.00 is required, if your passport was still valid or mutilated.
