## RENUNCIATION OF CITIZENSHIP OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

## **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:**

- Two (2) 'Form 13' of the First Schedule forms obtainable at the Embassy of Trinidad and Tobago. These forms must be completed and signed in the presence of a Commissioner of affidavits or Notary Public. (*contact our office for further instructions*).
- o Computer Generated Birth Certificate.
  - In instances where the applicant's name is not inserted on Birth Certificate or the name is incorrectly recorded, an affidavit (notarised) is required. If Trinidad and Tobago passport is not available, submit a notarised affidavit, which explains its absence.
- Trinidad and Tobago passport, if available.
- Marriage Certificate(s) and Divorce Decree(s) are required, applicable to women only.
- <u>Evidence of the acquisition of citizenship of the country of present nationality</u>. The original Naturalization Certificate is required.
- Letter addressed to the Minister of National Security stating the reason for renunciation.
- PAYMENTS: Money order for <u>\$22.00</u> is required. All payments must be made payable to "<u>Embassy of Trinidad and Tobago</u>" by money order only.
- POSTAGE: A money order for <u>\$28.75</u> (subject to change) must be provided along with a letter of authorization.
  - The authorization letter must include <u>full name</u> (addressee), <u>full address</u> of where the package should be mailed and a valid <u>contact number</u>. The authorization letter can also be found on our website at <u>www.foreign.gov.tt/embwashington</u> (Document – 13).

In cases where applicant is a citizen of Trinidad and Tobago by descent, the following additional documents are required from the parent through whom they obtained citizenship:

- Computer Generated Birth Certificate.
- Trinidad and Tobago passport.
- Marriage Certificate(s) and Divorce Decree(s).

Additional documents may be required on a case-by-case basis.
