DONATION OF 100,000 COVID-19 VACCINES FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA TO THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

On May 19th, the Embassy of the People's Republic of China officially handed over its donation of 100,000 Chinese Sinopharm Covid-19 vaccines to the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago.
